Percussion 2: Crotales, Chimes, Timpani (F-c, ossia: add D-A for lowest note) Tam-tam, Cymbal, Wind chimes (bamboo or wood), Siren, Hi-hat, Maracas

Percussion 3: Marimba, Vibraphone, Gongs (c¹ - c²) ², Tam-tam, 2 tom-toms (deep and high), Bongos, Snare drum, Hi-hat, Maracas, Triangle, Ship bell, Wind machine

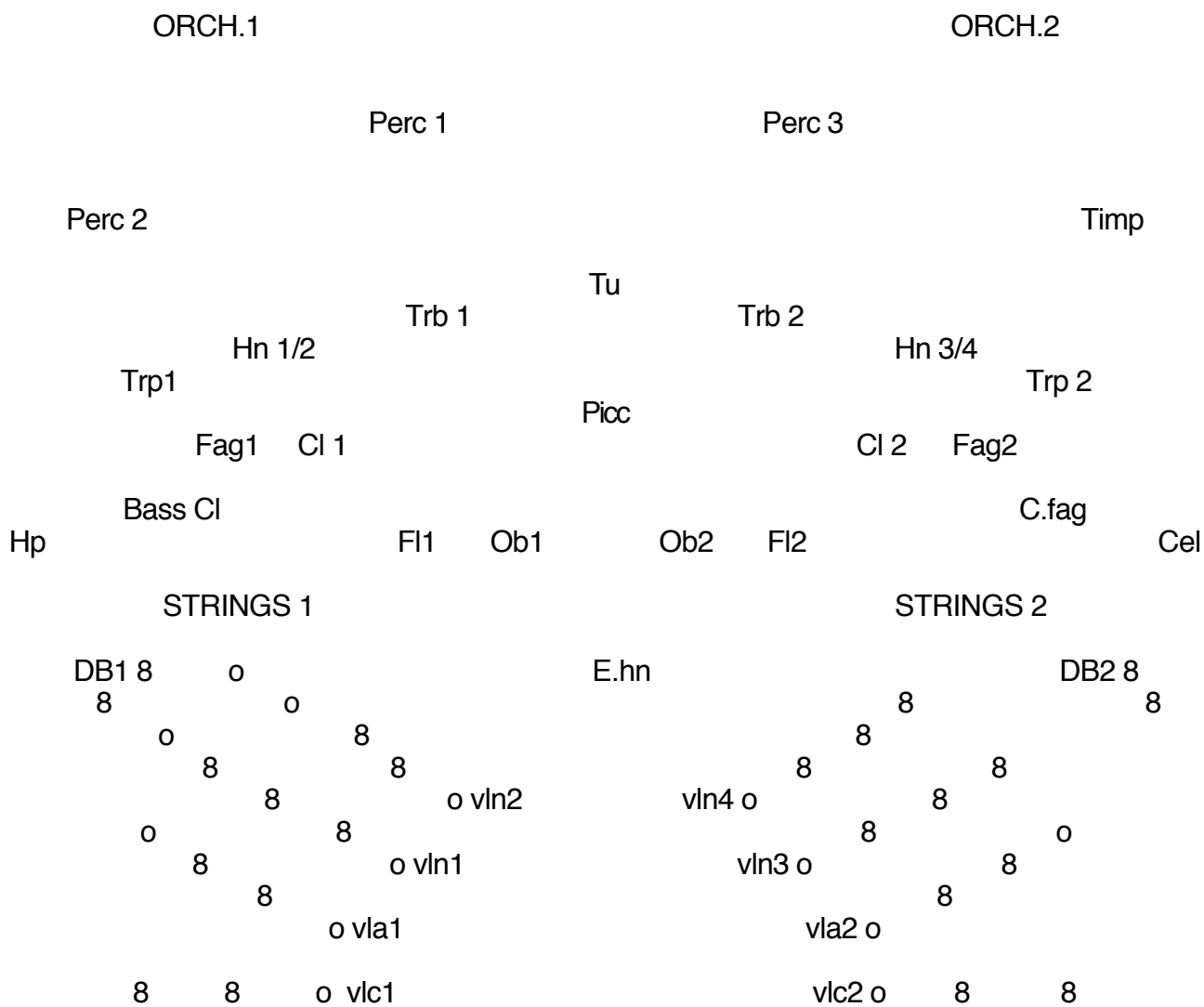
